



Faucet Installation


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- 1. Position the spout (14), hub base (2) and O-ring (23) on countertop. From underneath the countertop, assemble the clamp (26), locknut (27) and screws (28). Tighten the locknut by hand and secure the screws by screwdriver. Then attach the diverter assembly (47) to faucet as shown. Don't forget the washer (24).
- 2. Position the body 46 on countertop as shown, assemble bolt 10, clamp 1 and locknut 2, tighten with socket wrench 43.
- 3. Position the side spray 38 on countertop as shown, and fix it with washer 44 and plastic locknut 45.



Connect Hose Installation




- 4. Assemble side spray hose (18) to quick connect assembly (34). CAUTION: Make sure hose is properly engaged and secure in quick connect assembly.
- 5. Connect the connect hose ③ as shown. Connect with the body ④ by hand at first, and then connect with the diverter assembly ④ with adjustable wrench.

3 A. U B. U C. U O<

Connect to water supply lines with either:

- (A) 3/8 " O.D. Copper tubing (ball nose risers with the coupling nuts or;
- (B) 3/8 " Copper tubing (no ball) with supplied tube head interior connector or;
- (C) IPS faucet connectors (1/2 $^{\prime\prime}$)



Important:

Tighten connection with two wrench to prevent damage to tube body. Be careful not to bend the stem as this will void the product warranty.

Important:

Remove the aerator and let both hot and cold water run for one minute. To clear any line trash. This will help clean any debris that might clog the system. Re-assemble aerator.
