Proof of purchase from the original consumer purchaser must be made available for all warranty claims.

3 Hole Installation, 6" -10" Center-Set




Helpful Tools

Tools:

Gather the necessary tools as shown below to complete the installation of this faucet. Some may not be needed depending on the model of faucet you are installing. Check with your local hardware store on the requirements of your installation situation.



Connect to water supply lines with either:









- (A) 3/8 " O.D. Copper tubing (ball nose risers with the coupling nuts or;
- (B) 3/8" Copper tubing (no ball) with supplied tube head interior connector or;
- (C) IPS faucet connectors (½")
- Marning:The supply valves and supply lines are not included.



Important:

Tighten connection with two wrenches to prevent damage to tube body. Be careful not to bend the stem as this will void the product warranty.



Remove the aerator and let both hot and cold water run for one minute. To clear any line trash. This will help clean any debris that might clog the system. Re-assemble aerator.

Test system for leaks.




Parts Diagram



Faucet Installation




- 1. Shut off water supply and drain lines. Clean sink surface thoroughly. Make sure mounting area is clean and dry.
- 2. Position spout (6), spout flange (2) and O-ring (2) on countertop, from underneath of the countertop, assemble clamp (5) and locknut (26), tighten the locknut with basin wrench.
- 3. Position the handle ③ as shown, and assemble the clamp ①, locknut ① and screw ⑤. Tighten the locknut ② by hand and secure the screws ⑤ by screwdriver. Repeat the above steps for the other handle.
- 4. Position the quick connect hose ② as shown and fix it to faucet by using the clip ②.

Pop-up Installation

Instruction for product with drain option only




- A. Remove pop-up drain stopper 32. and flange 33 with top rubber washer 34 for pop-up assembly.
- B. Insert drain body from underneath of sink drain hole.Replace flange 33 and top rubber washer 34 back to drain body 38.Tighten flange as far as possible.
- C. Slide bottom rubber washer (35) on drain body up against bottom of sink. Tighten washer (36) and locknut (37) firmly against base for tight seal.
- D. Remove tailpiece 39 from drain body 38, add Teflon tape, replace tailpiece 39.

A. Replace pop-up drain stopper 32 to drain body 38 with o-ring in place, and align stopper hole with guide rod opening.

Pop-up Installation

Instruction for product with drain option only



- A. Remove rod guide nut 42 and rod ball plastic gasket 41.
- B. Insert horizontal rod 40 into drain body 38 and through hole in drain stopper 32.
- C. Replace rod guide nut 42 with rod ball plastic gasket 41 and tighten it.
- A. Insert lift rod 45 through hole on faucet body.
- B. Connect extend rod 44 to lift rod 45. Attach horizontal rod 40 to extend rod 44 using fittings 43, tighten screw.
