Proof of purchase from the original consumer purchaser must be made available for all warranty claims.




### Tools:



## Configuration








### Warning:

The supply valves and supply lines are not included.

Connect to water supply lines with either:

- (A) 3/8" O.D. Copper tubing (ball nose risers with the coupling nuts or;
- (B) 3/8" Copper tubing (no ball) with supplied tube head interior connector or;
- (C) IPS faucet connectors (½ ")



### Important:

Tighten connection with two wrench to prevent damage to tube body. Be careful not to bend the stem as this will void the product warranty.




### Important:

Remove the aerator and let both hot and cold water run for one minute. To clear any line trash. This will help clean any debris that might clog the system. Re-assemble aerator.



## **Preparation / Mounting**




1. Put faucet body, putty plate 17 in order on the counter.




2. Assemble clamp 19 and locknut 18 to the bolt 9 and tighten the locknut with appropriate tool.

### Pop-up Installation

Instruction for product with drain option only







- A. Remove pop-up drain stopper (21). and flange (22) with top rubber washer (23) for pop-up assembly.
- B. Insert drain body from underneath of sink drain hole.Replace flange 22 and top rubber washer 23 back to drain body 26. Tighten flange as far as possible.
- C. Slide bottom rubber washer 4 on drain body up against bottom of sink. Tighten locknut 5 firmly against base for tight seal.
- A. Replace pop-up drain stopper 21 to drain body 26 with o-ring in place, and align stopper hole with guide rod opening.

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### Pop-up Installation

Instruction for product with drain option only





- A. Remove rod guide nut 30 and rod ball rubber gasket.
- B. Insert horizontal rod 29 into drain body 26 and through hole in drain stopper 21.
- C. Replace rod guide nut ⓐ with rod ball rubber gasket and tighten it.
- A. Insert lift rod ②7 through hole on faucet body. Connect horizontal rod ②9 to extend rod ②8 using spring clip③1 to hold and adjust.
- B. Attach extend rod 28 with lift rod 27 by inserting lift rod through extend rod hole. Now adjust lift rod 27 to correct height and hand tighten extend rod screw.
